The Miraculous Medal
Mary appeared to Catherine Laboure, a novice at the motherhouse of
the Daughters of Charity in Paris at 140 Rue du Bac. Catherine (1806-
1876) was the daughter of a farmer and was the ninth of eleven
children. Catherine showed a special love for Mary: when her
mother died, Catherine climbed a chair to reach the statue of
Mary and clasping it to her chest, said, "Now, dear Blessed
Mother, you will be my mother." In January 1830, aged 24,
Catherine joined the Daughters of Charity.
On the night of July 18, 1830, Catherine saw Mary seated in the
choir of the motherhouse chapel. Catherine herself recorded the
incident, which she entitled, "July Conversation with the Most
Blessed Virgin, from 11:30 in the evening of the 18th until 1:30
in the morning of the 19th, St. Vincent's Day." (*more next week*).

Saint of the Week
S. Deiniol
Deiniol, otherwise known as Daniel, in English
and Latin.
Despite not having a fine education and
spending his early life as a hermit, he was
called upon to be the first Bishop of Bangor.
He founded a Monastery and the present
Bangor Cathedral, dedicated to Deiniol, is on
the site where it once stood.
Deiniol died aged 54, with many churches
dedicated to him in North Wales, where he
was well loved for his unrelenting religious
work,
Feast day 11th September
