Saint of the Week

S. Ita

Ita was born to a noble family in Ireland and her father wanted her to marry a nobleman, but when he had a message in a dream, he let her become a nun like she wanted. She went on to build a community of her own in Killeedy (later known as Ita's cell) where they taught young children - some who also became Saints. Ita had a special devotion to the infant Jesus so would sing him an Irish lullaby to mark the special love.

A Church was built in her grounds next to a spring well which became a Holy well when children were cured of smallpox and other diseases.

She is buried in the ruins of the Church, named after her, which is still a place of Pilgrimage today.
