#### S. James.

James was one of the twelve disciples and the first apostle to be martyred for his faith. He was also known as James the Great and the name James comes from the Italian name 'Giacomo'

While James was preaching the Gospel one day, the 'Virgin Mary' appeared upon a pillar, which is conserved to this day in Spain.

He died in Jerusalem and his remains are now where a Cathedral stands in Spain. Tradition states he appeared at several battles to fight for the Christian army.
