**Saint of the Week**  
**S. Benedict**  
 Benedict was the son of a Roman Noble who was so disgusted with the immorality while studying he dropped out to become a monk and lived in a cave for 3 years.  
 When he became Abbot of the local monastery the monks tried to poison him, but when he prayed over the cup it shattered. He left and went back to the cave but his miracles were becoming well known and a neighbouring Priest tried to get rid of him with poisoned bread. However, when blessing the bread, a raven swept down and took it.  
 Benedict founded 12 monasteries and in his last he died of a fever – not long after his twin sister.
