Saint of the Week
S. Anthony Mary Claret
St. Anthony Mary Claret was the 5th of 12 Children and when he went missing one day they knew he would be in the Church. He wanted to become a Priest but his Father wanted him in his weaving business. However, when his father sent him to a school of 'advanced weaving' St. Anthony went to Seminary instead. Aged 28yrs Anthony was ordained and had a strong devotion to Mary who appeared to him several times (hence the name Mary). Aged 42 he became Archbishop of Cuba where he reformed the Seminary and Ordained 200 men - the first ones for 30 years.
He died aged 63yrs.
