## Saint of the Week

### S. Winefride

St. Winefride was of Welsh royalty and Prince Caradoc wanted to marry her but when she constantly refused he became angry and cut her head off with his sword.

Her head rolled down the hill and when it stopped, water gushed out of the ground. Her uncle Beuno, who was saying Mass at the time, came out, saw her head, and gently picked it up and put it back on her shoulders; covering her with a cloak. He then went back and finished Mass praying for her the whole time, and when he returned to Winefride she sat up, with only a thin scar around her throat and neck.

Winefride went on to become a nun and the place where the water came out the ground has become a constant site of pilgrims - named Holywell.
