Saint of the Week

S. Deiniol

St. Deiniol was born in Wales and although of little education became the 1st Bishop of Bangor. The King of Powys gave his family land but when he was older he left for Gwynedd where, for a short time, he was a hermit. When he was Bishop, he founded a Monastery in Bangor, and the Present Bangor Cathedral that's dedicated to St. Deiniol is said to be on the site where his Monastery stood. Gladstone made a library from his own collection of 30,000 books and dedicated it to St. Deiniol, the library still remains, and is a spectacular building that is also residential. In English and Latin Deiniol's name is often known as Daniel. According to the Annales Cambriae St. Deiniol died in 584 and was buried on Bardsey Island; North Wales.
