#### S. Cecilia

Cecilia was from a rich family so was given in marriage to a young man named Valerian. Before the marriage was consummated she told her husband she had an Angel protecting her. Valerian wanted proof, so after being baptized he was able to see an Angel at her side who crowned Cecilia with a chaplet of roses and lilies. Valerian's brother also got baptized and could see the Angel, however it resulted in all three of them dying as Martyrs.

When her body was exhumed it was found incorrupt – the 1<sup>st</sup> of all incorrupt Saints, and it was also reported a flower like odour came from the coffin.
