**S. Andrew the Apostle**

Andrew was the older brother of St. Peter and both Fishermen. When Jesus was walking on the shore he saw the brothers and asked them to become disciples and "fishers of men". Andrew was at the last supper and died a martyr. When an army of Scots were greatly outnumbered in battle, their leader prayed that if granted victory he would appoint St. Andrew as the Patron Saint of Scotland. The clouds then formed an X shape in the sky so they took this as divine intervention and were victorious
