Saint of the Week
S. Illtud
Illtud was born in Monmouthshire; the son of a Prince, and cousin of King Arthur. His parents wanted him to join the priesthood so had him well educated. However, he chose a Military career and is sometimes known as 'St. Illtud the Knight'
When a hunting party went tragically wrong, all were killed except Illtud who went to the nearest Monastery and was told to go back to his religious upbringing. This he did and founded the first major Welsh Monastic School - which is now Llantwit Major. Illtud died aged 61 and was buried outside Brecon in the Church of Llanilltud, which, unfortunately, was demolished in the late 20th century.
