Saint of the Week
S. Vincent of Saragossa
He was educated and ordained to the Diaconate in Saragossa (Spain) and was also known as 'Vincent the Deacon'. The Bishop there had a speech impediment and asked Vincent to be his spokesman, so when the Bishop was arrested he went too. The Bishop was exiled, but Vincent died a Martyr and was thrown into the sea. His body, however, was protected by Ravens and found by Christians who built a shrine over his grave - which continued to be guarded by Ravens.
Th Island of St. Vincent in the Caribbean, was named by Christopher Columbus because it was discovered on 22nd January - St. Vincent's Feast Day.
