Saint of the Week
S. Barnabas
Barnabas was the cousin of "Mark the Evangelist" and is described as being a "good man, and full of the Holy Spirit and of Faith". He was known for his conversion of the "God fearing" Gentiles and giving all his money to the poor. He also travelled with Paul (Saul) on many of his missions.
Barnabas died a Martyr, and he appeared in a dream to the Archbishop of Constantia telling him where his remains were laid. The Catholics granted the Monastery of St. Barnabas to his followers and the order became known as the "Barnabites"
