Saint of the Week

S. Cuthbert

Cuthbert was born to a noble family but it is not known if he had any siblings. He became a Monk and Bishop, spending his time among the people ministering to their spiritual needs, preaching and performing miracles. It is also said he founded St. Cuthbert's Church in Edinburgh.

He died aged 53, and eleven years after his death his body was found to be perfectly preserved. However, the Monastery was attacked and the monks fled with the body of Cuthbert and laid him to rest in Durham.

Hundreds of years later his tomb was opened so that his remains could be put in a shrine behind the altar of the new Cathedral. In his casket was a small book of the 'Gospel of John' and is the oldest Western book in its original bookbinding.
