When her mother died she was left utterly destitute and her neighbours who shrank from the stench of her loathsome sores could see she did not have long to live.

When her body was lifted from the rotting plank it was covered in white violets – she was only fifteen

The whole town went to her funeral and many miracles occurred before, during, and after her burial.
