Saint of the Week
S. Anselm

Anselm was born of noble birth and was well educated - his specialities, among many, were Metaphysics and Theology. He wanted to join a Monastery at 15 but his father wouldn't allow it, so it wasn't until he was 27 years old and his father had died, that he became a monk.
Anselm soon rose to Abbot and although he was exiled twice for his beliefs, he wrote many books - 'Doctrine of the Atonement' being most remembered.
Aged 60 he became the Archbishop of Canterbury until his death 16 years later.
