**Saint of the Week**

**S. Corona**

Corona was born to a wealthy family but died a martyr in Roman Syria at only 16 years old. Her Gold relics were taken by a German - probably a Priest - who buried them in a crypt at a Cathedral in South Germany.

Her remains, however, were taken to North Italy along with Saint Victor who was also killed for his faith at the same time.

When the German Cathedral was under repair, St. Corona's relics were found and put in a shrine. This year, they were taken out to be displayed for an exhibition in the summer - this was before the Corona Virus outbreak!

**For you to Prepare!**

A Jug of water, a bowl and towel or towels – for Thursday.  
2 pieces of wood:

- 1). 6"-7" (15-17cm) by about 1" (3cm) wide x 1/2" (1 cm).
- 2). 4" (10cm) by about 1" (3cm) wide x 1/2" (1 cm).
- 3). Some string (thinnish).
- 4). Two pieces of thicker string ( about O ← that size) one 8" (20cm) and one 4" (10cm).
- 5). Also you need for carpet tacks and a small hammer and scissors
