Saint of the Week
S. Mario
Mario was the youngest of 9 children. At 17
years old he entered the seminary and at
24 years old he was ordained a Priest.
He was sent to Burma on missionary work
and in a small village he opened an
orphanage with regular liturgy lessons and
celebration of the Sacrament.
After world war 2, when the nation gained
independence, Mario died a Martyr aged 39
years old
