Saint of the Week
S. Boniface
Boniface was born into a prosperous family
and, against his fathers wishes, he attended
a monastery from an early age.
He was a teacher at the Abbey before
becoming a Priest aged 30 years old, but
instead of taking up the post of Abbot, as
expected, he set out on a missionary
expedition, preaching and writing.
The high point in his career was when he
started to chop down the 'Donar's tree' and a
great wind, as if by a miracle, suddenly blew
the tree down. The people were amazed and
immediately converted, so he built a Church
from the wood at the site.
It was while he was waiting for his converts
that a group of armed robbers appeared and
killed him aged 79 years old.
