Saint of the Week S. Paulinus

Paulinus was born into a wealthy, aristocratic family and his
father made sure he had a good education. Subsequently he
became a well known lawyer and poet. Although he never
wrote any theological works, he was responsible for the
world's first biography which was about 'Saint Augustine'.
When Paulinus was 36 he retreated from the world and came
to be baptised, 3 years later he was ordained a Priest, then
later again a Bishop,
Paulinus helped to establish a community of monks and to build
a hospital and an aqueduct. He also re-built a Church in honour
of Saint Felix who he credited with his conversion.
Paulinus gave all his money to the poor and was well liked and
respected until he died aged 77 years old.
