**Saint of the Week**  
**S. Kateri**  
 Kateri was four years old when her parents died of smallpox.  
 She also caught the disease but survived. However, her face  
 was left terribly scarred.  
 Aged 19 Kateri converted to Catholicism and took a vow of  
 chastity; she also took her baptism name - Catherine. The  
 rest of her community, including her adoptive parents, were  
 not happy with her decision so she had to flee to avoid  
 persecution.  
 Kateri was known for her steadfast devotion and ill health,  
 but suddenly, aged 24 years old, she fell ill and died. It was  
 said after she died her scars disappeared and her face  
 became smooth.  
 Kateri was canonized in 2012 and was the first Native  
 American to be recognised as a Saint by the Catholic Church.
