Saint of the Week
S. Gregory
Gregory was born into a wealthy noble family and well
educated. His great, great, grandfather was a Pope and
his mother and two Aunts were made Saints.
When Gregory's father died he made his family home
into a Monastery, calling it Saint Andrew the Apostle.
Gregory was best known for his writing and the reform
of the Catholic Church, it was his life's work, driven by
his conviction that the Church was 'founded by God'.
Gregory was chaplain and Papal advisor for a series of
Popes before he became Pope himself, making his family
the most distinguished clerical dynasty.
Gregory 'the Great' as he was later know, died aged 64
and his relics are enshrined in St. Peter's, Rome.
