Saint of the Week S. Clare

Clare was the eldest daughter of a wealthy family, but after hearing St. Francis preach when she was 18 years old, she left home to join the Benedictine Nuns; much to her father's distain.

When so many other women wanted to be brides of Christ, Clare founded the order of 'Poor Clares' and wrote the 'rule of life' which was the first monastic guide lines to be written by a women; although many Religious leaders tried to challenge these rules.

When an army came to attack them, although very sick, Clare went to the gates with the Blessed Sacrament and prayed. A voice answered her and said "I will keep them always in my care" and in that moment the men ran away in fright.

Clare soon became too ill to attend Mass but said to the others she could hear and see it on the wall of her room. She

died shortly afterwards at the age of 59.
