**Saint of the Week**  
**S. Wenceslaus**  
Wenceslaus was born into nobility and was well educated.  
He was known for getting up on cold snowy nights, and in bare  
feet, would give money to the widows, orphans, those in prison  
and any one in need.  
Hence, Wenceslaus was the subject of the popular St.  
Stephens day Carol, and the title of king was given to him  
posthumously by a Roman Emperor.  
Wenceslaus was challenged to a duel and when his opponent  
advanced towards him he saw two angels by the side of  
Wenceslaus so threw himself at his feet instead.  
Wenceslaus died aged just 23 years old Martyr, when his  
jealous younger brother killed him.  
There is a statue of St. Wenceslaus on his horse in  
'Wenceslaus Square' and his helmet and armour are in Prague  
Castle. September 28<sup>th</sup> is a public holiday in the Czech  
Republic in celebration of St. Wenceslaus.
