Saint of the Week S. Deiniol

Deiniol - also known as Daniel - was the son of an Abbot in Powys. He was educated by St. Cadoc of Llancarfan, near Cowbridge, and spent most of his early life as a hermit.

When Deiniol was older, he moved to Gwynedd where he founded a Monastery in Bangor, and although he didn't have a formal education, he was made the Abbot and the first Bishop of Bangor; where he spent his last days. The present Bangor Cathedral is dedicated to Deiniol as it stands where his Monastery stood and a recent shopping centre is also named after him.

Many Churches are dedicated to him including a village name Llandeiniol 'Parish of St. Deiniol',
