Saint of the Week
S. Wilfred
Wilfred was born into a noble family and entered religious life
as a teenager, studying at Canterbury and Rome.
Wilfred set up schools and became the religious advisor to
the Northumbrian queen. He introduced the Rite of St.
Benedict into the Monasteries he founded and Choral music.
Wilfred was also known for fighting for the 'Roman method'
of calculating the date of Easter, to be introduced in England.
However, Wilfred had a lot of opposition to his ways and was
often exiled. He was greatly criticised for dressing his
household and servants in clothing fit for royalty, and also
abducting a young lad who had been promised to the Church
but the family had changed their mind.
Wilfred died of a stroke aged 76 years old and when a
commemorative service was held on the anniversary of his
death a spectacular white arc appeared in the sky - starting
where his bones were laid to rest
Feast day 12th October
