### Saint of the Week S. Paul of the Cross

Paul was the second of 16 children and born into a poor family. He was educated by a Priest and when he was 26 years old he had a series of prayer experiences calling him to God.

After a short course in Theology he was ordained a Priest and spent life as a missionary where he became well known for his preaching and generous acts of mercy.

Paul built many Monasteries, although, he liked to call them retreats because of the solitude and contemplation. A few years before he died he set up a place of contemplative Sisters and all the communities were called 'Passionists' He died aged 81 years old in one of the retreats he had founded, and more than two thousand letters of spiritual direction were found which have been preserved.
