**S. Simon - the Apostle**  
Simon was on the beach casting his fishing net with his brother  
Andrew when they saw Jesus. Jesus asked them to come with  
him, so they dropped their nets and followed.  
To distinguish him from Simon Peter, one of the other  
disciples, he is called Simon The Zealot because of his zeal  
for Jesus' teaching.  
Simon was also known for carrying the cross for Jesus  
through the streets at the Crucifixion.  
Simon died a Martyr and is buried in St. Peters Basilica.
