Saint of the Week
S. Gertrude
Gertrude entered the Benedictine community when she was 4 years old as an orphan and taken under the wing by the sister of the Abbess.
Gertrude soon became a Nun and when she was 25 years old, experienced her first visions which she would have all her life. She wrote them all down but most of them mysteriously went missing after her death, although a few remain.
Gertrude embraced charity and, nursing end of life patients; even when she became ill herself she never waived on her devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and helping others.
Gertrude died aged 46 years old.
