Saint of the Week

S. Dyfrig

Dyfrig was the son of a princess born in Hereford.
When the baby Dyfrig kissed his grandfather he
cured him of his leprosy.

Dyfrig founded two monasteries where he taught
many, that later became Saints. He became the
Archbishop of Caerleon and his disciples were
active in the expansion of Christianity in Powys and
Somerset.

He retired after hearing St. Dewi preach then died
3 days later at approx. 80 years old.
